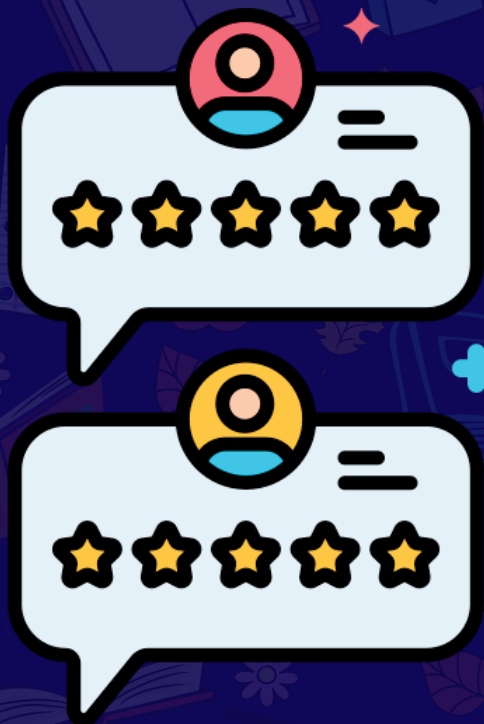

1. You can select any book in the form of a collection of Short Stories, Novels, Biography or Autobiography for Book Review. (English)
2. Review word limit: 800 words.
3. All the participants will receive an E-Certificate of Participation.
4. **Plagiarised Content will be disqualified**
5. Last Submission Date: **December 7, 2022.**
6. **Book Review Format:**
 - a. Name, College, Class and Roll no.
 - b. Title of the book
 - c. Author/s of the book, Edition, Genre and Pages
 - d. Your Review of the book
 - e. Reason for choosing this book
 - f. Favourite part of the Book and Why
 - g. Would you recommend this book to another person? Why?



FILM REVIEW

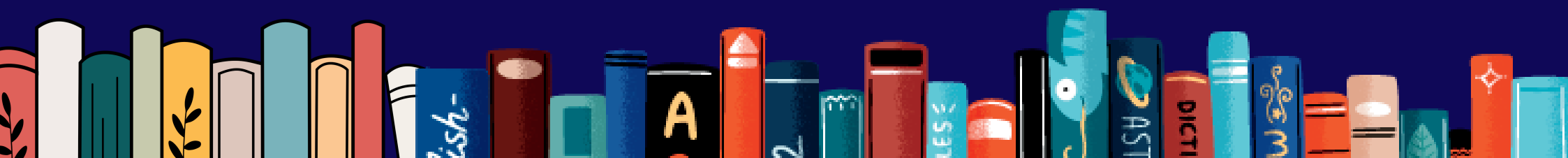
1. Open genre
2. Reviews in English or Hindi only.
3. All the reviews must be in a **video format.**
4. The length of the review should be between 5-7 **minutes.**
5. One submission per reviewer.

1. Word Count: 800 words.
2. All the participants will receive an E-Certificate of Participation.

BOOK NARRATION

1. Participants will be asked to select a book of their choice.
2. 1 Minute to introduce themselves and the book.
3. Random chapter would be asked to read out
4. Participant must read in a manner that expresses the words in the most accurate tone, effect and emotion possible.
5. All the participants will receive an E-Certificate of Participation.
6. The last day for Registration is 7th December 2022



POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

1. The participants will need to bring their poster-making material and stationery.
2. The poster size should be A4.
3. All participants will be given 60 minutes to finish their posters.
4. All the participants will receive an E-Certificate of Participation.
5. Prizes for the best 3 posters.
6. Themes for the poster making:
 - a. Climate Change
 - b. Importance of Mental Health
 - c. Your Favourite Book
 - d. Impact of Mobile Phones on Humans
 - e. My Utopia/Dream World



BOOKMARK MAKING COMPETITION

1. The participants will need to bring their bookmark-making materials and stationery.
2. Bookmark Size: 8 inches x 2 inches of cardboard.
3. Time Limit: 40 Minutes
4. All the participants will receive an E-Certificate of Participation.

 - b. The Motto of Life/Life Quote
 - c. Reading as a Habit
 - d. Self Description



QUIZ COMPETITION
