**Clean Air Campus Initiatives**

St Pauls Institute of Communication Education For Women (SPICEFW) had pledged to actively coordinate cleanliness activities in the college and beyond the campus with the vision of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. It commits to continuing with this program.

The broad vision is as follows:

1. Generating mass awareness of cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular cleanliness drives. The idea is to motivate them to contribute proactively.
2. Activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' will be a key component of all the community work being done by the NSS of the college.
3. Staff members will be encouraged to participate in the cleanliness drive on the college campus.
4. Events such as poster and slogan competitions, essay writing, spoken word poetry, speeches, and skits on 'Swachh Bharat' will be organised.
5. Rallies on themes connected with 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' in and around the college campus will be conducted to create mass awareness.
7. Remove all kinds of waste material like broken furniture, unusable equipment, etc.
8. Administer the pledge by students and staff members to maintain the cleanliness of the college campus and its surrounding areas on an annual basis.
9. Conduct workshops on the 3 Rs: reduce, reuse, and recycle waste.
10. Commit to managing waste and maintaining a clean campus, especially during college events.
11. We encourage our students and staff to use public transportation. Train concessions are given.
12. We encourage carpooling to college, an activity that will control air pollution and strengthen social interaction.
13. The entry of automobiles inside the campus is limited to discourage the use of private vehicles.

**Smoking Free Campus**

Smoking, including the use of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, electronic cigarettes, and other smoking devices, is strictly prohibited within the campus premises. This prohibition extends to all indoor and outdoor areas, including classrooms, offices, corridors, common areas, and open spaces.
